1. Introduction

The Headmaster, M H S, Puthencavu on behalf of The Manager, M D Corporate Schools, Devalokam, Kottayam, invites sealed tenders for the Supply and Installation of Aluminium Composite Panel (ACP) as per the design and specifications outlined by the Church authorities. The work includes the supply of all materials, labor, and necessary equipment for the proper execution of ACP cladding works using the tray form fabrication method.

2. Scope of Work

The work includes but is not limited to the following:

- I. Supply and installation of Aluminium Composite Panels (ACP) of an approved brand.
- II. Tray form fabrication method must be employed to ensure neat and clean finishes.
- III. The ACP cladding shall adhere to the design specifications provided by the Church authorities.
- IV. All framing, pasting, and fixing materials must meet the required technical specifications and be suitable for outdoor conditions.
- V. Silicone pasting and jointing material must be UV resistant and suitable for ACP work.
- VI. The contractor shall present samples of all materials for approval before finalizing the order.
- VII. On completion, the installation must provide an aesthetically pleasing and durable surface as per the approved design.
- VIII. Providing Docktail / Magnum brand alu-zinc corrugated tile pattern roofing sheet with all necessary bracket moulding and fixing the same on to existing RCC columns of the building.

3. Material Specifications

The contractor must provide detailed specifications of each material used in the project, including but not limited to:

3.1 Aluminium Composite Panel (ACP)

- I. Brand: To be approved by the School authority, The tenderer shall provide the choice of his company's brand of which all technical specifications and guarantee / warranty conditions shall be presented in writing along with tender document. Thickness: Minimum 4 mm, consisting of a nontoxic polyethylene core sandwiched between two aluminum sheets.
- II. Finish: PVDF/FEVE coating for long term durability, weather resistance, and UV protection.
- III. Colour: As per the approved design, matching the aesthetic requirements of the School.

IV. Sample of roofing sheet used to form verandha in the eastern side of auditorium shall be presented and all service conditions shall be detailed along with tender.

3.2 Framing Material

- **I. Material:** Aluminum / galvanized steel frames with necessary brackets, screws, and anchors of approved brand like Jindal shall be used.
- **II. Dimensions:** Adequate dimensions to support ACP panels and provide structural stability shall be provided and shall be mentioned in the tender after proper investigation of site conditions.
- III. Finish: Anticorrosive coating suitable for outdoor conditions.

3.3 Silicone Pasting Material

- I. Type: UV resistant silicone sealant suitable for ACP applications.
- II. Brand: Approved by Church authorities.
- III. Adhesion: High adhesion to both ACP and framing materials, ensuring long term bonding.

3.4 Jointing and Sealing Material

- I. Sealant: Weather resistant, durable sealant for joints between ACP panels.
- II. Material: Neoprene gaskets, German Technology (Wacker) or equivalent, approved for outdoor use.

4. Fabrication & Installation

- I. Method: Tray form fabrication.
- II. Mounting: ACP panels shall be mounted on the structural frame with concealed fasteners.
- III. Alignment: Ensure proper alignment, spacing, and uniformity of panels.

5. Quality Standards

The contractor is expected to comply with relevant quality standards, including: IS 15983 for ACP sheets. & ASTM C920 for silicone sealants.

6. Sample Submission

Contractors are required to submit physical samples of the following materials for approval before proceeding with the work:

- I. ACP sheet.
- II. Framing material.
- III. Silicone pasting material.

7. Work Schedule

The contractor must submit a work schedule detailing the timelines for material supply, fabrication, and installation.

8. Safety Measures

The contractor must ensure all safety regulations are followed during the installation process. Appropriate scaffolding, harnesses, and protective gear must be used.

9. Warranty and Maintenance

The contractor must provide a warranty of at least 5 years on all installed ACP materials and workmanship. This includes resistance to delamination, fading, or structural failure.

10. Submission of Tenders
